





Deck plan




Promenade deck



Daily program

1st day, SATURDAY

Embarkation in Venice between 15:00 and 18:00. Departure for Zadar at 19:00. Welcome drink and dinner on board.

2nd day, SUNDAY

At 7:00 the ship sails into Zadar, a cultural, economical and administrative centre of the northern Dalmatia. It is a site of archaeological and monumental treasure from antic, medieval and renaissance periods. Natural beauty, numerous coves and beaches, cultural historical monuments, various services - all of these make Zadar and its surrounding area a very attractive Croatian tourist destination. In the Zadar hinterland, these is a unique natural object of exquisite beauty, the oldest and the largest Croatian National park Plitvice Lakes. Departure for Ploče at 18:00.

3rd day, MONDAY

At 7.00 the ship sails into Ploče. Geographic position of Ploče ensures attractive and historically interesting surroundings. When you come to Mostar, you will see the way in which that town of sun, greenery and flowers stood for many centuries on the crossroads of various civilizations, and every civilization left its print on Mostar. The famous bridge over the Neretva river was re-built in 2004,, and after that, it was placed on the UNESCO list of world cultural heritage. As a second option, you can choose to go from Ploce and join millions of the worshippers who daily make pilgrimage to the Sanctuary of the Queen of Peace in Medjugorie. Besides the appearance of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the other miracle in Medjugorje is a sculpture which "sheds tears" in an inexplicable manner. Departure for Korčula at 15:00.

3rd day, MONDAY

At 18:00, the ship sails into Korčula, a medieval town on the homonymous island. Korčula is famous by the ancient chivalric game called "Moreška", whose tradition was kept for 400 years. Take a walk through the old Korčula surrounded by medieval walls, discover the secrets of numerous civilisations that left their mark on the island, visit the birth house of Marco Polo. Departure to Kotor at 22:00

4th day, TUESDAY

Sail in the morning through the extraordinary Kotor bay, once ruled by the Illinian queen Teuta. The ship will berth in Kotor, located at the furthermost end of the bay under the high cliffs of Mount Lovcen. Discover old Kotor and the picturesque towns of the Montenegrin coast: Sveti Stefan, Budva and Milocer, Departure from Kotor is scheduled in the evening for an overnight sailing towards Dubrovnik.

5th day, WEDNESDAY

Early morning arrival into Dubrovnik. Meet the southern nemesis of Venetia and spend the whole day in the town which is a unique museum in the open air. Find out why George Bernard Shaw said: "Those who search for the Paradise on Earth should come to Dubrovnik." In the summer months, you will also have the possibility to visit near islands of Elaphite archipelago, known by their beautiful sandy beaches. Departure to Pula at 19:00.

6th day, THURSDAY

In the dawn, while sailing toward Pula, you can enjoy the view to the Kornati islands. The ship sails into Pula at 12:00. This 3000 years old city whose landmark is the magnificent Roman amphitheatre dating from the 1st century AD, is rich with valuable cultural and historical monuments which often provide the stage for famous artists. A visit to the nearby National park Brijuni - a chain of islands of extraordinary natural beauty and rich historical heritage, should not be missed. Beside the seascape, you can discover the uniqueness of Istria on the excursion into the land-locked areas. Picturesque Grożnjan and Motovun, protected area of Limski channel and the representativeness of Rovini will complete your impressions of Istria as one of the most attractive European destinations. Exactly at midnight the ship will sail to the open sea, so it can reach the Slovenian waters by the morning.


7th day, FRIDAY

At dawn, the ship will sail into the Koper harbour, and the admirers of natural beauties will certainly choose the adventure of visiting the magical underground world and enjoying 20 km of galleries and halls. Visit to Postojna cavern will certainly be one of the most unique experiences. We will complete it by visiting the Predjamski grad and the fortress which proudly oversees historical events for centuries. Departure from Kopar to Venice at 14:00 hours. Sailing into Venice along St. Mark's square, followed by the splendour of the Doge's and many other palaces, is always an extraordinary experience. Spend your last evening on board with the view over this magical city on the lagoon.
