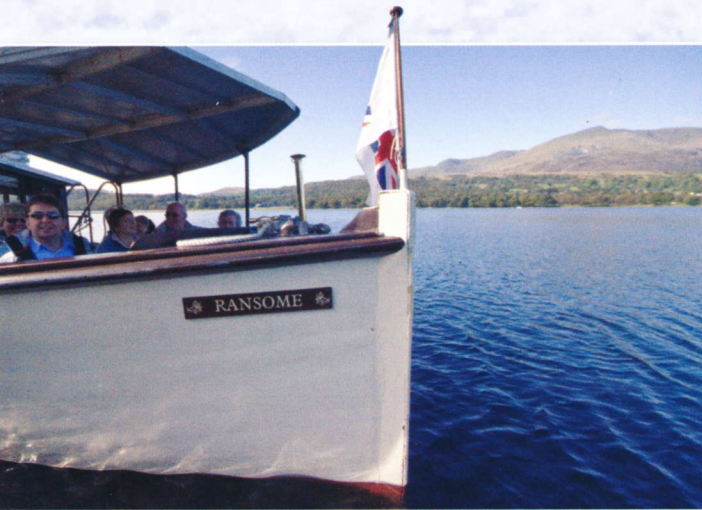

The spectacular lakeside position makes it one of the most beautifully situated houses in the Lake District.

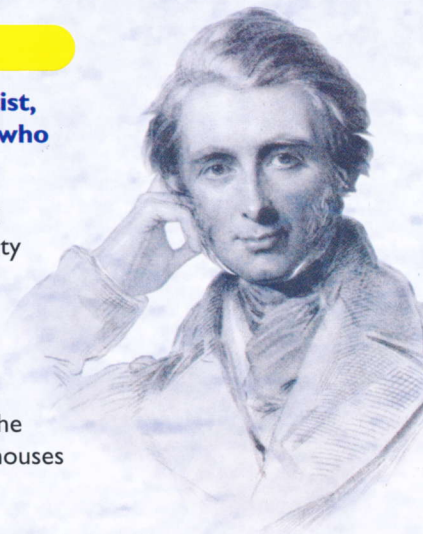
Brantwood was the home of John Ruskin from 1872 until 1900.
