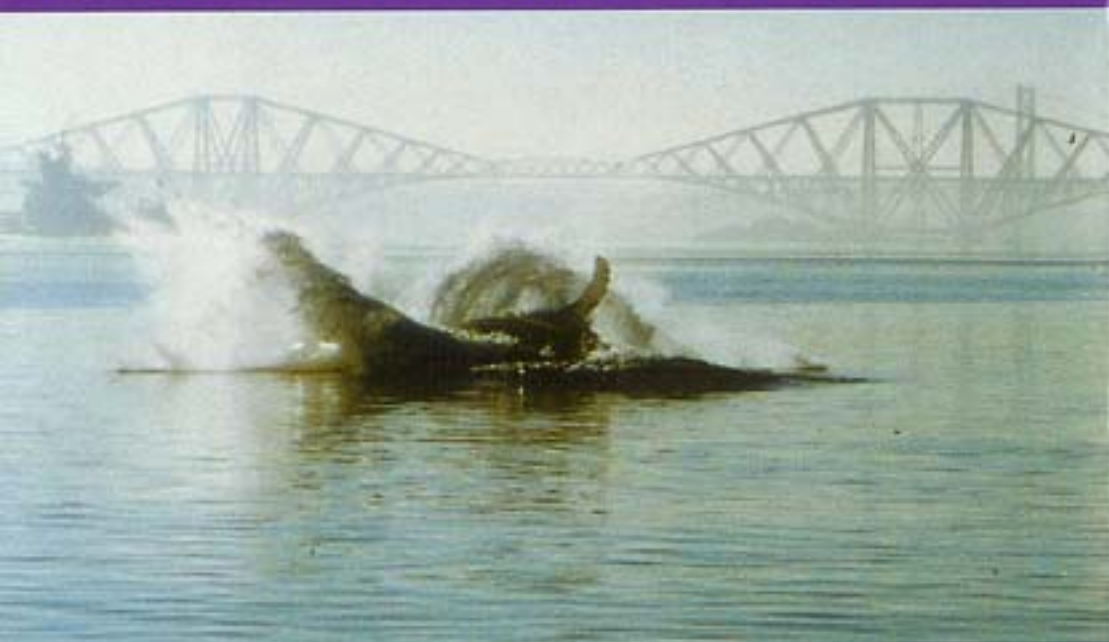


# Marine Wildlife in the Forth

Occasionally we get more unusual visitors such as the Humpback Whale, (Top Pic) Orcas (Middle left) Dolphins and Porpoises. For several years we had a resident favourite 'Donny the Dolphin' who regularly used to ride on our bow wave.

# ITS SO QUICK 'N EASY TO GET TO SOUTH QUEENSFERRY

## BY TRAIN (£3.50 RETURN)

From Edinburgh Waverley to Dalmeny Station(South Queensferry).  
Trains every 20 mins or less and a journey time of only 15 mins.  
Then a short walk down the path from Station to Hawes Pier under Forth Rail Bridge

## BY BUS (£3.60 RETURN)

From Edinburgh Princes St., First Bus No. 43 every 20 mins  
(Journey time is about 35 mins).  
Get off at Rail Station and a short walk down to Hawes Pier

## BY CAR (FREE PARKING)

From Edinburgh, follow signs for Forth Bridge then Brown Tourist Signs for Inchcolm Abbey Ferry. Postcode for your GPS is EH30 9TD

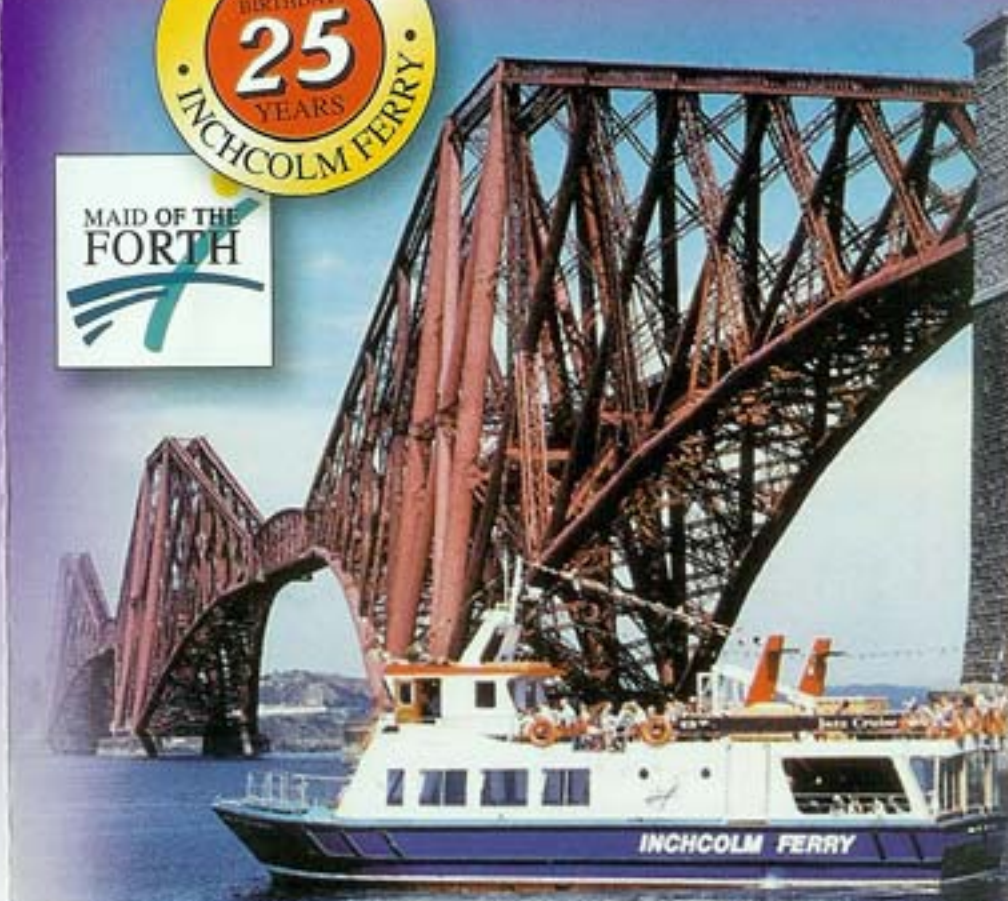
