
## How to find us

**By Road** Aylsham is situated mid-way between Norwich and Cromer on the A140. The station is signposted as you approach Aylsham (NR11 6BW). Wroxham Station (NR12 8UU) can be found on Coltishall Road (B1354), close to the town centre. There are large free coach and car parks for passengers at both stations.

**By Rail** Wroxham Station is adjacent to the Bittern Line Railway Wroxham (Hoveton) Station which offers direct services from Norwich, Cromer and Sheringham. For connecting train times, please call National Rail enquiries on 0845-7.48.49.50.

**By Boat** Wroxham Station is situated a short walk from the town centre. This makes the Bure Valley Railway the most convenient tourist railway for anyone holidaying on the Broads.

**By Bus** Regular services run to both Aylsham and Wroxham.

Boat Trips start and finish here



A 15" gauge railway built in 1990 and mainly operated by steam locomotives. It runs for 9 miles between Aylsham and Wroxham with intermediate stations at Brampton, Buxton and Coltishall.
