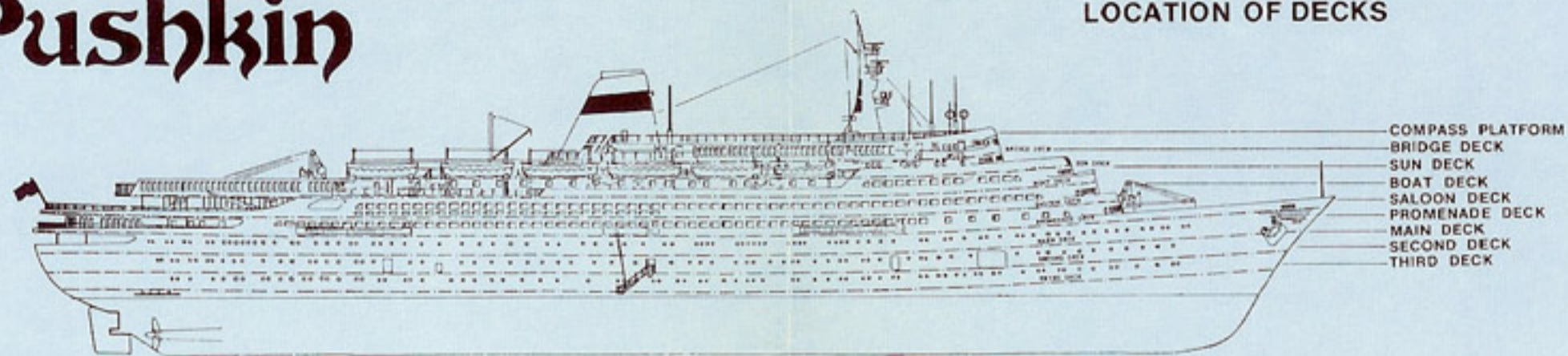

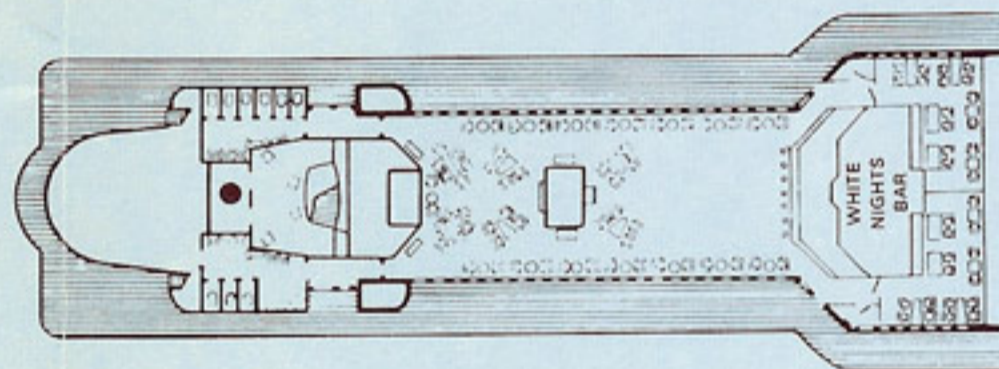

LOCATION OF DECKS

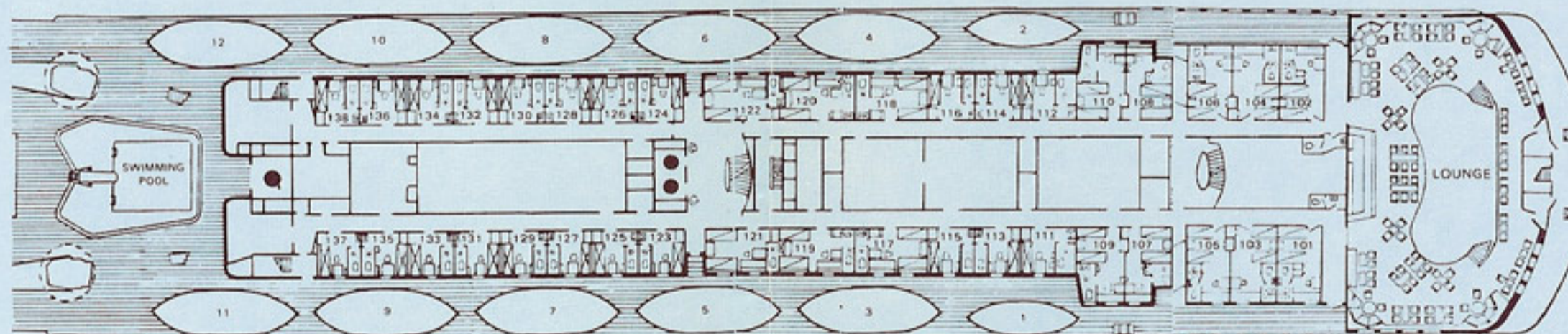
