#### Visit Brantwood

Sail to Brantwood, the former home of John Ruskin, poet, artist and social reformer. Visit the house, garden, craft gallery and bistro. Discounted tickets are available on board.

#### Take the Bus

Take advantage of the 'Ruskin Explorer' ticket including fares for Bus and Boat, plus Brantwood House. The 505 Stagecoach service runs from Windermere and Ambleside. Alternatively take the 525 'Cross Lakes Shuttle' from Bowness, via boat & bus.

Buses interchange at the Waterhead Hotel where you can, if you wish, enjoy light refreshments before boarding the launch. Call Traveline on 0870 6082608 for bus timetables.

#### **Get Walking**

With seven jetties around the lake there are opportunities for walks along lakeshore footpaths and quiet country lanes using the boat one-way, or boat-walk-boat. For further information ask our friendly crew.

Why not buy a pack of walk leaflets? These give you the freedom to plan 'one way' fell walks using our jetties.

#### A Bite to Eat

The 'Jumping Jenny Coffee House and Restaurant' at Brantwood, the 'Bluebird Cafe by the Lake', or the 'Waterhead Hotel' with its own jetty, all provide excellent food and are accessible by Coniston Launch. No picnics in the boat cabins please.
