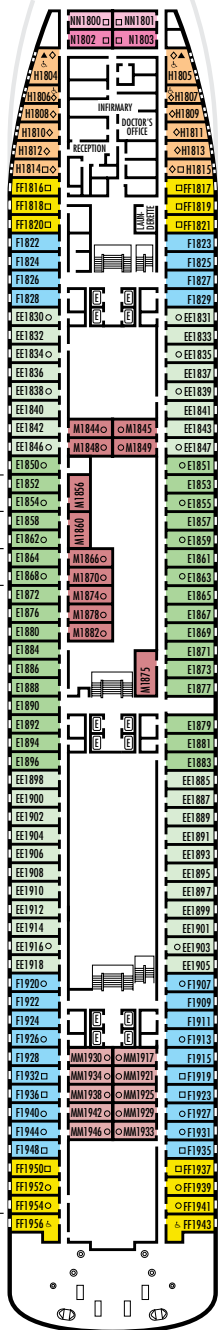

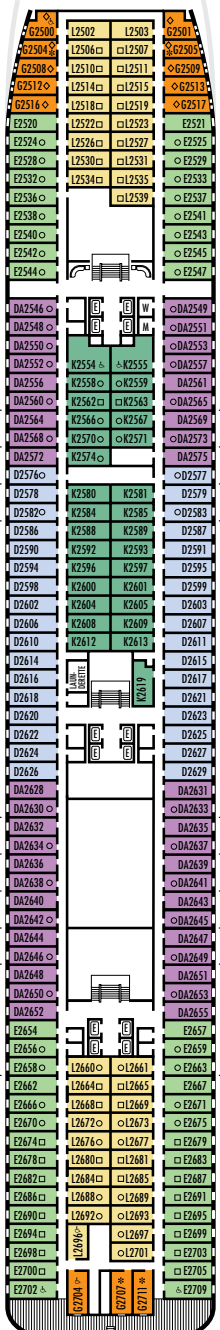


DOLPHIN DECK

to Staterooms 1800 & 1801.



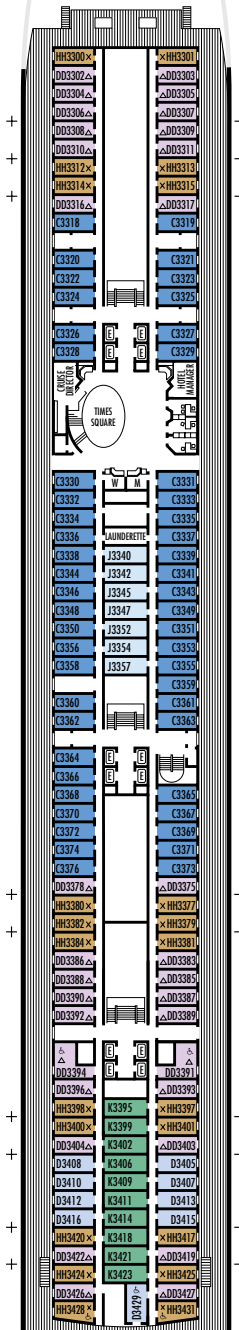

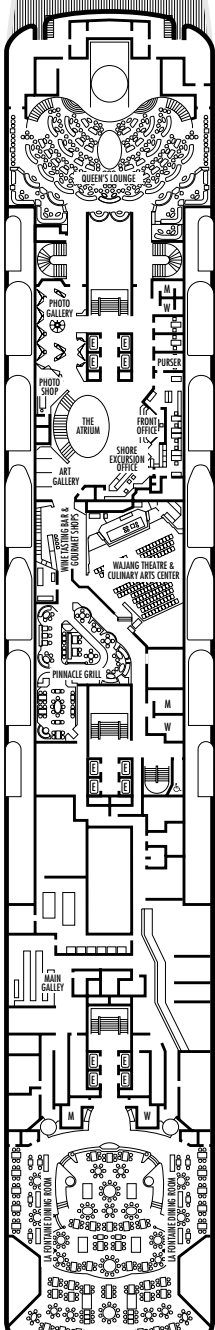

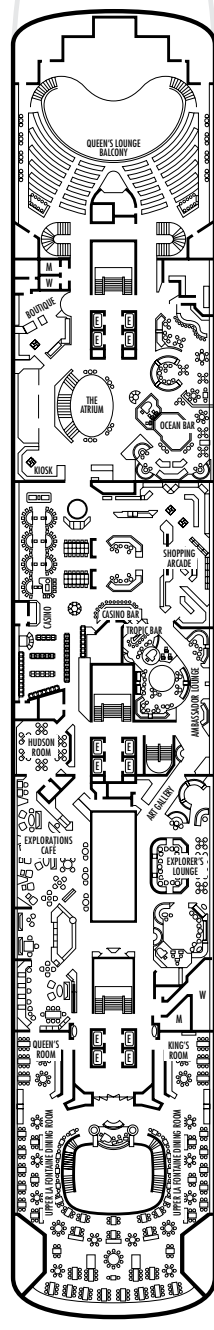

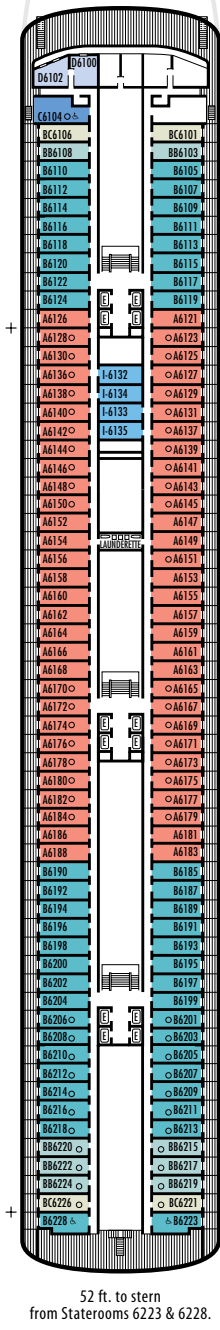
PROMENADE DECK



UPPER PROMENADE DECK

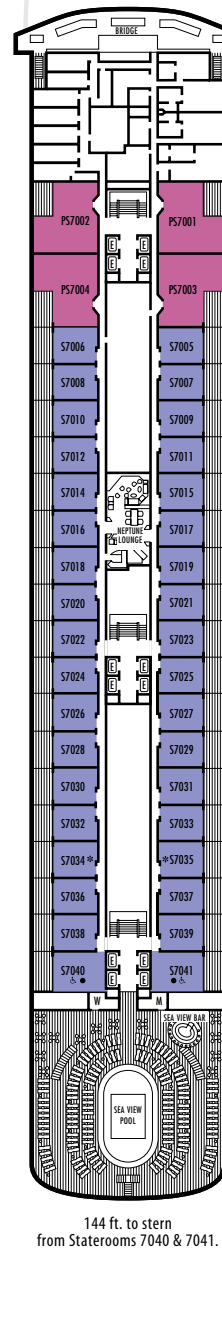


VERANDAH DECK

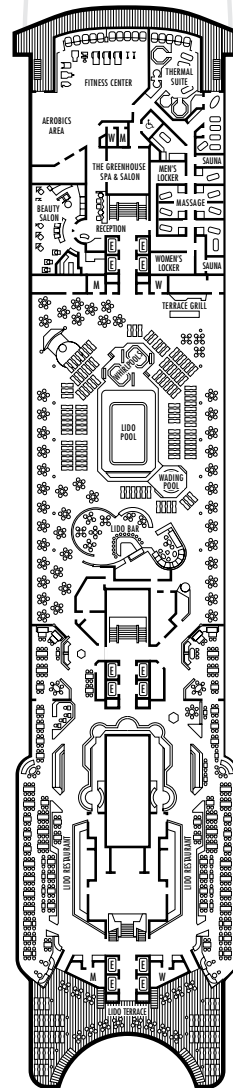

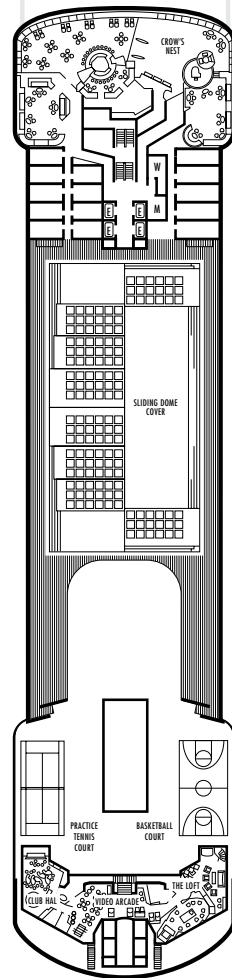

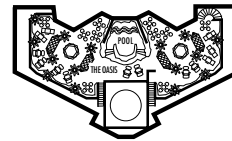

DECK PLANS & STATEROOMS

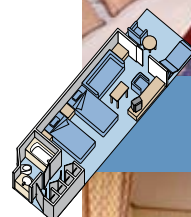

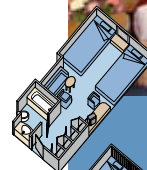
PENTHOUSE VERANDAH SUITE
approx. 1,159 sq. ft. with verandah



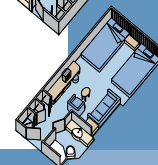
DELUXE VERANDAH SUITE
