
Marine Wildlife in the Forth

The Forth is a rich environment for Sealife, we get regular sightings from Guillemots to Gannets and from Peregrines to Puffins. Occasionally we get more unusual visitors such as the Humpback Whale, (Top Pic) Orcas (Middle left) Dolphins and Porpoises. For several years we had a resident favourite 'Donny the Dolphin' who regularly used to ride on our bow wave.

Then a short walk down the path from Station to


Hawes Pier under Forth Rail Bridge




"Inchcolm Express Adventure"


Timetable for 2008




