Reservations

Reservations are required to be made in advance and accommodation cannot be guaranteed unless prior reservation is made. Every passenger over the age of three years must have a berth reservation as stipulated by the Board of Trade. Reservations can be made with your travel agent or through the motoring organisations. You are requested to use the Booking Form inserted into this brochure. Read the instructions for use carefully and it will ensure that we can process your reservation as quickly and efficiently as possible.

Passengers are strongly recommended to take advantage of the special personal and car insurance covers arranged by Swedish Lloyd with the Guardian Assurance Group with cover to the following limits: See Sailing Schedule

150 lbs. of personal baggage is allowed free of charge per passenger. All baggage should be correctly labelled. Trunks, furniture etc. cannot be accepted as personal effects and must be shipped as cargo - contact a shipping agent who will supply the necessary documents. If you are taking your car, pack your baggage so that you take to your cabin only what you require for the actual voyage. The car deck will be open during the voyage at the discretion of the Ship's officers. Passports etc.

A valid passport is necessary when travelling to Spain, Portugal or Scandinavia. If you are taking your car, you will require a "green card" from your insurance company. Do not forget your vehicle registration ("log") book and G.B. plate. For Spain you will need an international driving licence (obtainable from the motoring organisations) and Bail Bond insurance (obtainable from your insurance company).

Currency

Passengers should observe the existing currency regulations. Swedish Lloyd Money Vouchers

To help your currency go further you may purchase Swedish Lloyd vouchers in sterling before leaving England. These can be used for all onboard expenditure on both outward and return voyages.

EMBARKING AT SOUTHAMPTON

Swedish Lloyd vessels are berthed at Princess Alexandra Dock (Gate No. 2), Southampton. Embarkation commences at 17.00 hours. Passengers and cars should report not later than 18.00 hours. The vessels sail at 18.30 hours.

EMBARKING AT BILBAO (SANTURCE)

Swedish Lloyd vessels are berthed at the 'Ferry Station', Santurce, 9 miles from the centre of Bilbao. Embarkation commences at 17.00 hours. Passengers and cars should report not later than 18.00 hours. The vessels sail at 18.30 hours.

Passengers are strongly advised to allow themselves ample time in which to make their journey to Bilbao/Santurce on day of embarkation.

EMBARKING AT TILBURY AND GOTHENBURG Embarkation commences at both Tilbury and Gothenburg at 15.30 hours. Passengers and cars should report not later than 17.00 hours; caravans not later than 16.30 hours. Vehicles booked on to the Container Deck must report before 15.00 hours. The vessel sails at 17.30 hours.

Cars are marshalled by officials prior to loading to ensure speed and efficiency.

Sailing Times

M.S. Patricia and M.S. Hispania depart from both Southampton and Bilbao at 18.30 hours, arriving at their destinations approximately thirty-six hours later at 07.30 hours.

M.S. Saga sails at 17.30 hours, arriving at London approximately thirty-eight hours later at 07.30 hours or at Gothenburg at o6.30 hours, approximately thirty-seven hours after departure.

Bus Services

SOUTHAMPTON

On sailing days a bus departs from Southampton Central Station at 17.45 hours, arriving at the Passenger Terminal at 17.55 hours. On arrival days a bus leaves the passenger terminal at 08.35 hours, arriving at Southampton Central Station at 08.45 hours. The fare is 1/2 including baggage.

BILBAO

Buses run at 10 minute intervals starting at 07.00 hours from Calle Ayala, Bilbao to Santurce and from Parque de Santurce to Bilbao. The fare for adults and children over 4 years is 7 ptas. There is also a regular train service at 15 minute intervals Bilbao/Santurce and return. On arrival days there is a special bus service "Viajes Ecuador" which departs from the passenger terminal at Santurce approximately 45 minutes after arrival.

TILBURY

On sailing days a bus connects the Passenger Terminal with the 14.35 hours train from Fenchurch Street Station, arriving Tilbury Riverside Station at 15.15 hours. Tickets obtainable at Fenchurch Street Station. On arrival days buses are provided between the ship and Tilbury Riverside Station. Trains depart for London every half-hour.

GOTHENBURG

On sailing days a bus departs at 15.00 and 16.00 hours from outside platform 11 at Central Station for Skandiahamnen. On arrival days buses leave Skandiahamnen at o6.50 hours and 07.45 hours for Central Station. The fare is Sw.Kr. 3.
